Current Routes Running

- **LOS ANGELES ROUTE:** From Fox Hills/Crenshaw Boulevard/Hancock Park
- **SUNSET ROUTE:** From Pacific Palisades through Brentwood, Westwood and Beverly Glen

Additional routes may be added pending demand.

Costs: 2011-2012 bus fees will be determined in spring. Cost for the current 2010-2011 school year is \$2,400.00 (Less than \$12 a day). According to the *American Automobile Association (AAA)*, it currently costs 54.1 cents per mile to drive a passenger vehicle in the United States. If you live more than 10 miles from campus you are already saving money; and think of the time you would save!

Bus Registration: Registration will begin June 1, 2011. Please check the Campbell Hall website (www.campbellhall.org) for the latest information. Again this year, the entire bus registration process will be online. A \$500 deposit and submitted application will be required to reserve a spot. Space is limited and is first-come, first-served basis. Pro-rated rates and guest passes are not available at this time.

Schedule: Buses leave their first stop at 6:50 a.m. There are two afternoon buses, one immediately after school at 3:40 p.m., and a late bus at 5:40 p.m. A 2011-12 route schedule is provide on the back.
